

Tandem Club National Rally 2014 - Short walks from the Treborth Campsite

OS maps 114 or 115


These walks use the back entrance out of the campsite through the Botanical Gardens. See the map for details.

WALK TWO - 3 1/2 miles

Campsite → Nearest Supermarket (Waitrose) and Ynys Tysilio / Church Island.

Using the directions above go into the Botanic Garden and walk out along the road towards the Menai Suspension Bridge. At the junction turn left and cross the bridge. Built by Thomas Telford and completed in 1826 it leads across to Porthaethwy / Menai Bridge. (More information is available at http://menaibridges.co.uk, or in the Canolfan Telford Centre opposite the Waitrose Carpark.)

At the end of the bridge continue along the A5 and bear left around the roundabout. Pass the Anglesey Arms (or call in!) and continue to Waitrose – the nearest supermarket to the campsite. This is the flattest way to do your shopping. Continue straight on and just past the Jade Garden Chinese Restaurant there is a *foot*path to the left signed Ynys Tysilio / Church Island (GR 552 717). Follow the clear path through the car park and down, fairly steeply, through woodland towards the tiny church on the island in the middle of the Menai Straits. Watch out for red squirrels! It is possible to walk round the graveyard and enjoy some beautiful views up and down the tidal Afon Menai, (in Welsh the Straits are regarded as a river). Return across the causeway and follow the Belgian Promenade alongside the water towards to the bridge. Turn left up Lon Cei Bach and continue back up to the Anglesey Arms. Trace your footsteps back across the Suspension Bridge and through the Botanic Garden to the site.
